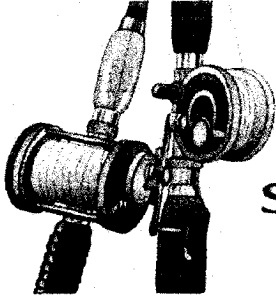
The Schroon Lake Fish and Game Club will hold a chicken barbeque for \$10. [Pre-registration](#)

The popular Anniversary Booklet published for the 50th Anniversary will be reprinted with additional pages featuring all the classes and various memorable events from last 25 years.

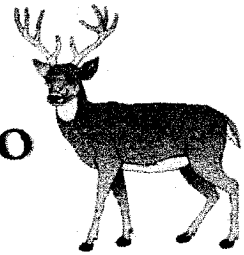
