The Essex County Hatchery is once again on the verge of being closed down. This news come to us via Doug Moline who has been fighting hard to work with protecting the future of the Warren County and essex County Hatchery. The Hatchery will be part of the new budget vote for the county. one option is with the hatchery remaining open and the pther will be with the hatchery closing. in the past budgets were allowed to go over 2% increase but under Cuommo's new policy it must be voted on if it goes over. I am told the way the Essex County board will present the new budget is with and without the hatchery. If the tax payers elect not to pay the difference in taxes the hatchery will be closed, thus losing aprox. 4,000 two and three year old trout on the Ausable River alone, the State gives us 1,200. I don't think I need to tell you what not having fish in one of our most popular rivers would mean to the economy and the shops that rely on these fish. Please make your voice heard to the all of the town supervisors and board members of Essex County as well as the head of it, Randy Douglas. ****Again I am sending this out as a message to our members but not on the behalf of Trout Unlimited...we have not had a chance to discuss this and the next meeting is not until 11/08 I don't think this can wait that long to try to preserve the hatchery.
