Don - The solution for this and most fo thesmall game speicies is really quite simple - we need to cut more trees and thus more early successional (brush) habitat. Wht was the deer rifle of preference in the 1960s - a Winchester lever action 30-30. Why - becasue it is a brush gun with open sights. What is the rifle of preference today - something that will shoot flat for 250 yards equipped with a 3 X 9 power scope. Why - because there is no understory (the woods are open) and thus no green plants beneath the mature forest canopy which equates to no food and cover for wildlife - both hunted and non-hunted. Mike
